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A treasure chest of culture, history and traditions

From the Neanderthal man to the present day, human presence has designed the Feltrino territory writing history in a large “open-air museum” composed of archaeological areas, museums and exhibitions, castles, hermitages, sanctuaries, churches, fortified cities, villages, rural buildings and military works. Eventually, important events have led this museum to come alive and change shape.

These signs alone deserve the effort of a journey, but even more so when they come into contact with buoyant traditions that, year after year, reinvigorate the monuments and streets of the towns.

A TERRITORY EXPLORED SINCE PREHISTORY

Numerous discoveries have taken place in the lands of Feltre. From the pre-Alpine peaks that tell of the first settlements up to the great works of rural development. Historical finds are the emblem of a land between Rome and continental Europe.

The Carbon 14 test dated it to 12.040 years from the present: consequently, the experts claim it could be a Cro-Magnon man dating back to the Epigravettian period. Buried with extraordinarily beautiful painted pebbles, the Man of Val Rosna represents, in addition to the anthropic testimony in the lands of the Feltrino - and in particular in the area of Sovramonte - the authentic artistic expression produced in Europe by Paleolithic humans.

Several excavations and findings from the second half of the twentieth century have confirmed that the entire area of Monte Avena, the western end of the Belluno Dolomites, was frequented by humans at various times in history and thanks to its particular characteristics, represents a unique site in Italy and Europe. It seems that the first settled and organized populations of Feltrino date back approximately to the 5th century BC and that one

of the main urbanization centers was the town of Feltre.

Today this village has the appearance of a fortified medieval citadel, entirely rebuilt after the fire of 1510, with alleys, stunning views and traditional artisan shops.

There are also numerous outdoor frescoed works located under the arcades or within the refined Renaissance palaces. On the slopes of the Colle delle Capre - where the village stands - under the churchyard of the Cathedral, there is an archaeological area of about 1000 square meters which preserves the testimonies of the most ancient stages of city life. Here, you can admire a portion of an urban neighborhood in the Roman center of the ancient "Feltria".

During this period, the Romans were mainly concerned with modernizing the already existing road system, expanding it and making it more efficient. An example of an ancient Roman road that after 2000 years of history reawakens into a new chapter with the advent of eco-tourism is the Via Claudia Augusta Altinate.

It is not a simple road, but a real international bridge - from the Po to the Danube - which unites three countries, mixing culture, environments and emotions. This passage through the territories of the Feltrino area is remarkable and returns to the visitor the memory of a distant past when, at the height of the splendor of the imperial age, the

men of the legions of the army of Rome passed through these places to reach germanic lands.

The first stop in Feltrino is represented by Lamon, where the ancient Roman bridge and the Archaeological Museum "The Roman necropolis of San Donato" are easily accessible. Then the Via Claudia Augusta goes through Sovramonte and Pedavena up to Feltre. Next, the road climbs up to Cesiomaggiore crossing Villa Centenere, one of the milestones of the road and finally proceeds towards Busche, crossing the Piave River and continues on its left bank. Even in the lands of lower Feltre the testimony of past centuries is present in all its beauty: in Alano di Piave, for example, there is a geosite exposed along the banks of the Calcino torrent, in the valley of the same name, which dates back to about 40 million years ago. Made up of gray marls, sedimentary rocks composed in varying proportions of limestones and clays, they represent a glimpse of history that opens up to the present and testifies to the environment of the past.

TEATRO DELLA SENA

A jewel at the heart of the citadel

Where Venice meets the Dolomites: Feltre, a vertical city that has always been characterized by its role as a link between the plains and the alpine highlands, and precisely from this intense relationship with the two worlds, discovers its function as a small city.

"It is beautiful, it is splendid, it is enchanting ..." This was how the nineteenth-century historian Antonio Vecellio described the town of Feltre. Two centuries later, the charm of this small urban center has further increased thanks to a series of recovery and enhancement projects that make it today one of the most beautiful and best preserved examples of a Renaissance town in northern Italy.

The pride of the village, located in a large hall originally used for meetings of the city council, is the Teatro della Sena. This temple of the arts is also called "the little Fenice" because it owes its current forms to Gianantonio Selva, architect of the famous Venetian theater "La Fenice". In 1802 this character was in fact charged with the radical restructuring of the rooms, creating a structure whose acoustics are perfect.

The theater is preciously decorated by the paintings of Tranquillo Orsi, also the author of the grandiose curtain that is currently undergoing renovations. Among the artists who performed on the Feltre stage there

is the great playwright Carlo Goldoni who represented two of his first comedies here. It was in Feltre, as he himself recounts in his memoirs, that he discovered a passion for the theater. Emotions in art and living history, the Teatro della Sena will leave you ... breathless!

THE EXCELLENCE OF HAND MADE

Authentic craftsmanship is in our DNA



The love for craftsmanship is celebrated in numerous fairs and events that characterize the season in the Feltrino area. The citadel of Feltre, in particular, tells of the love for artistic craftsmanship through a museum dedicated to Carlo Rizzarda, the Galleria d'Arte Moderna (Gallery of Modern Art). In addition to the art tools of the aforementioned - one of the most important wrought iron artists of the early twentieth century - it holds a series of highly prized collections. Among other artists are Picasso, Egon Schiele and Casorati. Wood is also a material widely used by artists in this area. A museum with a wooden theme is to be found in San Gregorio nelle Alpi, and is dedicated to marquetry and ancient maps: the Museo della Zoca, della tarsia e delle mappe antiche. Woodworking is one of the elements that characterizes this town - also remem-

bered by the evocative street whose lamps are always off (Viale delle lampade spente) in memory of miners - there are in fact over 250 wooden sculptures made from logs of particular shapes, to which are added the works of marquetry, an ancient technique in woodworking. A town still characterized by flourishing industries and an important commercial center is Fonzaso. It is worth noting that in the past it also had an economy mainly based on trade and woodworking, which came directly from the woods of Lamon and Sovramonte. In these areas, finally, the supply chain that was born from the processing of wool was particularly active, and still today finds its flagship in the indigenous breed of Sheep of Lamon (Pecora Razza Lamon), a sheep whose authenticity of taste is also recognized.

TO REMEMBER IS A DUTY OF ALL: FELTRINO AND THE GREAT WAR

During the period of the Austro-Hungarian occupation, and until the Liberation, streets, squares, palaces and monuments were transformed adapting to the different needs of the war.

One of the strongest and most heartfelt themes that the history of the entire Belluno area has in common is certainly in relation to the two world wars, which in this valley found the strategic theater of the toughest battles, particularly during the first conflict. Unforgettable moments and memories, not only relived through the words of the survivors who were direct witnesses of such barbarism, but also brought to light by numerous museums, memorials to the fallen and tributes, as well as by marks left in the environment that still bears the signs. A first info point with historical photographic exposure, documentation and indications on the Great War itineraries is located in Prà del Moro di Feltre. The largest open-air museum is certainly represented by the informal network of the “Museo diffuso

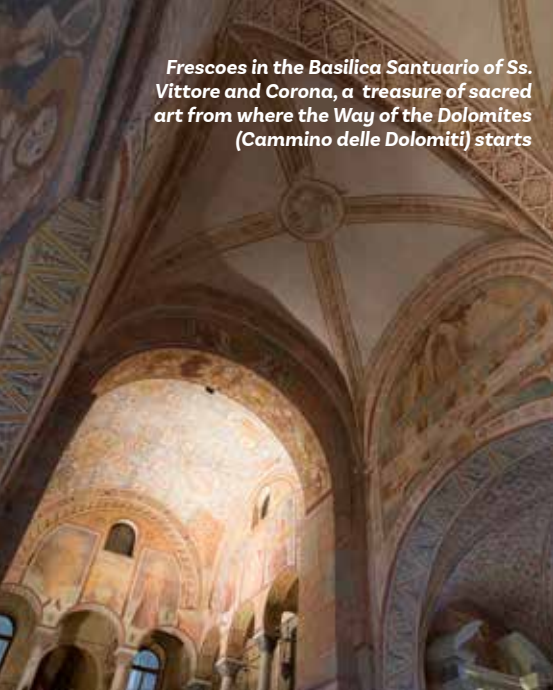
del Grappa” which also extends beyond the province. The facets of this niche of museums are varied, starting from a small photographic collection located in two rooms of the Seren del Grappa Service Center, called Museo fotografico della Grande Guerra “Eugenio Secco” (Photographic Museum of the Great War “Eugenio Secco”) which aids in understanding a period that passed into history as “an de la fam” (literally, “the year of hunger” in bellunese dialect - 1917/1918). It is also an ideal starting point for excursions that culminate in Monte Grappa and in the other crucial points of the opposing sides in the great battles of World War I in this area, such as the “Bosco degli eroi” born in 2014 from the desire to remember the many lives broken on the battlefield, the feelings and fears of simple soldiers in a

new perspective of peace. We also find museums more specialized, like the MUST - Civic Historical Museum of Alano di Piave - which collects objects, documents and iconography related to WWI and the consequent forced emigration of the population who found themselves at the center of war events and had to leave the inhabited areas to take refuge in safer places like the nearby Feltre, Friuli and the other regions of central Italy. Also in the lower Feltre area, Quero was almost totally destroyed during the Great War. In this municipality stands the Monumento Ossario, dedicated to the over 4000 Austro-Hungarian and German soldiers who fell in the battles of the Piave and Grappa, in addition to Museo del Piave “Vincenzo Colognese” (Piave Museum “Vincenzo Colognese”) - located

in the hamlet of Caorera and right next to the river sacred to the Motherland, the Piave - which exhibits numerous war relics, from helmets to bayonets, from uniforms to photographs and even objects from the new-born aviation weapon which, as a whole, tell the dramatic events of those years.

Forte Leone of Cima Campo in Arsiè was never used in battle since it was cut off from the front as a result of the events of Caporetto, but today it represents an open-air department where you can relive history. The work was part of the Brenta-Cismon dam and was built by the Italians between 1906 and 1912 and had the task of providing shooting coverage throughout the surrounding area for a radius of almost 12 km.



TREASURES OF SACRED ART

Where spirituality and ritual meet

Jewels with a small bell tower emerge from a clearing or from the top of a hill. Easy to reach on foot or by bicycle, they constitute in part a real itinerary, like the path of the piedmont churches (Percorso delle chiesette pedemontane), which from San Gregorio nelle Alpi leads to the mountains of Feltre. Overall, instead, they represent a symposium of treasure chests where one can admire the art that meets the sacred and is highlighted in unique and symbolic projects.

Frescoes, altars, crucifixes and iconographies of particular beauty accompany the visitor to discover centuries of very important works set in the walls of these places of worship.

Not to be missed in Alano di Piave, the Chiesetta di San Lorenzo in the locality of the same name; the Church dedicated to San Valentino (Saint Valentine) of Quero Vas; the Madonnetta in Pez di Cesiomaggiore; but also the small church of Sant'Antonio near Saltoi di San Gregorio nelle Alpi; in Rivai di Arsiè, the little church of San Lorenzo; the church of the Feltrina fraction of Umin, honored at San Marcello; Santa Maria Ausiliatrice in Milies di Segusino; the small church of San Nicolò in the village of Arten, in Fonzaso; the elevated Church of the Madonna del Caravaggio in Arina di Lamon, the church of Santa Maria Maddalena in Porcèn di Seren del Grappa, the church of San Giorgio di Sovramonte, and finally the one dedicated to Santa Susanna in

the Municipality of Pedavena.

While on the subject of the sacred, on a road unintentionally called "Via Paradiso" (paradise road), we find a milestone of the sacred art of Belluno and beyond: the Museo Diocesano di Feltre (Diocesan Museum of Feltre). Located inside the

ancient bishop's palace in

the historic center, it was built in the second half of the thirteenth century.

Today this place awakens to a new prosperity with the modernization of the premises that hold thematically organized instalations

containing religious art from the early Middle Ages to the present-day.

An itinerary that from the Dolomite peaks reaches the plains, to be covered on foot or on two wheels, fully enjoying the magnif-

icent natural landscapes and the rich and ancient history of religious art of the checkered territory of Belluno is the Via dei Papi. This path is divided into several stages that lead to places related to four great Popes in the last three centuries and touches some fractions of the territory of the right bank of the river Piave. The start of stage number 6, is located at Santa Giustina at the Col Cumano spirituality center, dedicated to the memory of the Belluno Pope Albino Luciani (Giovanni Paolo I), from here we descend until we reach the main road that continues through the little villages of the municipality of San Gregorio nelle Alpi.

In the Prealpi Dolomites every place holds a gastronomic treasure, each product constitutes a heritage capable of communicating taste, healthiness and territory.



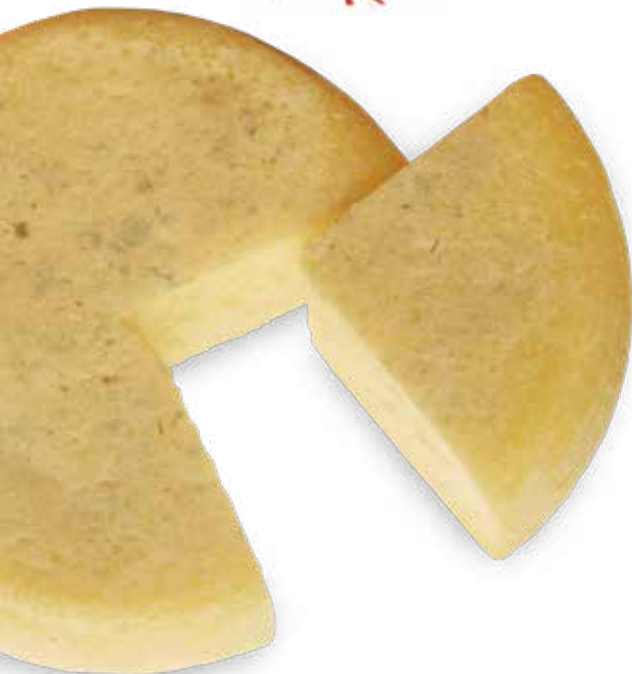

In Feltrino we strongly believe that one of the best ways to get to know our territory is - literally - taste it! Various landscapes are reflected in the wide biodiversity of products and the combination of Venetian and Dolomitic gastronomic traditions offers a mouth-watering experience! This corner of paradise narrates through its flavors the profound relationship between the environment and the people who live it.

History, tradition and excellence are recognized in every product.

There are numerous goods protected by special patents, which recognize and preserve their uniqueness. Among these is the the Noce feltrina (feltrina walnut), which, associated with mountain organic milk and the art of ice cream making - for which the people of Belluno are famous - gives refreshing notes on the palate in the summer and is also used to garnish sweets and crunchy biscuits, breads and salads.

Products that recall the warm colors of autumn are surely Sovramonte's Pom Prussian - a kind of apple - that offers both a tasty and energetic juice and "Kodinze" which are dried apple chips perfect for all ages; but

also the Chestnut and the Morone Feltre (a distinctive chestnut), particularly renowned for the sweetness and powderiness of their pasta, characteristic of the Valle di Seren del Grappa and sporadically cultivated throughout the valley, specially in the Cesiolina area, of San Gregorio and Santa Giustina.

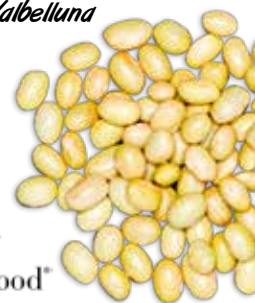
Very well known are the ancient flavors of the beans Fagiolo di Lamon PGI and Giolet - Slow Food Presidium - Bonel di Fonzo and the pumpkin Zucca Santa Bellunese, particularly noticeable in the lower Feltre area - Quero Vas and Alano di Piave - from which the gnocchi of pumpkin are a must, but also new "inventions" to explore, such as Bir-Zucca, a sweet beer made with pumpkin.

Speaking of beer, dolomitic barley is another excellence! This is the basic ingredient from which the Dolomites beer is made, which accompanies many traditional dishes from Belluno and finds its center of gravity in Pledavina: the oldest beer factory in Italy. The kitchen does not only give great satisfaction to the palate, it is also a reason for celebration and union between people, as in the case of the Potato De.Co di Cesiomaggiore,



Fagiolo di Lamon IGP. This product takes its name from the Alpine plateau where it is grown using traditionally ecological methods. The brand bears witness to the excellence and refinement of taste

cultivated according to a rigorous production process that makes this ingredient sought after and suitable for different types of preparations: from the most elaborate potato pie, to simple and delicious roasted or boiled potatoes, up to... record dishes, like the longest dumpling of the world! Yes, in 2018, the Belluno area entered the International Book of Records with a 1,037 meter long potato dumpling!

The milk supply chain in the Feltrino area also enjoys various international awards, as in the case of the Piave PDO, which takes its name from the homonymous

river sacred to the homeland. The intense and full-bodied flavor of this cheese varies according to the time of maturation - from 60 days to over 18 months - which takes place in an environment with controlled temperature and humidity.

In all its varieties the "formaj" - Piave, as well as the Bastardo or Morlacco del Grappa typical of the area of the same name, or the S-check of Segusino - is perfect to be enjoyed alone or accompanied by the classic Sponcio corn polenta and it is

particularly valued in the Cheese Route of the Belluno Dolomites, an itinerary that leads to pleasures and discoveries of the most authentic local tradition: from the small dairy to the large semi-industrial production.

Finally, the Schiz is a typical and exclusive product of the province of Belluno, a fresh cheese with an intense milk flavor, to be sautéed in a pan with butter, salt and cream to create a golden crust and to be enjoyed with Sponcio corn polenta and Pastin: large grilled meatballs crafted of pork, beef and lard, flavored with a mixture of spices.

From the valley to the high altitude rock walls, the green charm of the Dolomiti Bellunesi National Park with its natural surroundings makes Feltrino the ideal place for sports lovers, from the most dynamic - climbing and parachuting - to more relaxing and detoxifying walks in the open air, Nordic walking at high altitude, MTB or road bike, yoga or horseback riding. Natural rock climbs, such as the Valle dello Schievenin di Quero Vas or the fonzasino side, near the hermitage of San Michele of Monte Avena are perfect for those who love to experience the mountains vertically. Canyoning in water caskets is also a guarantee of fun and fresh emotions.

The citadel of Feltre, with its evocative alleys, represents a perfect place for orienteering in full urban style, while Monte Grappa is a great landscape where to combine historical-themed walks with the tastes of the mountain hut and pastures, also present in Cesiolino, in the area of San Gregorio nelle Alpi, Sovramonte and Alano di Piave.

Want to change perspective and see the world from above, like an eagle? Monte Avena is the ideal place for free-flight professionals, but also for those who want to experience the thrill of flying for the first time by jumping on a two-seater!

Interactive and curious about the themes of the Park and the activities to be carried out in it - with its "Machine of questions" - is the "Centro Visitatori il Sasso nello Stagno" in Pedavena, which can answer all the curiosities about the over 1400 species of plants flowers and local fauna. Similar in the naturalistic themes addressed is "La Santina", the Environmental Training Center of the park located in Val Canzoi.

There are many routes available and of varying difficulty for lovers of walks and emotions on two wheels, identified by special signs. Thanks to the places of interest they pass through, the combination of sport and historical, artistic and cultural interests is guaranteed.

The ancient roman road among the UNESCO Vette Feltrine

The Via Claudia Augusta Alinate is the ancient road sought in 15 BC by the Roman general Drusus Major - adopted son of the Emperor Augustus - that served as a link between the plain and the Alps during military campaigns in present-day Austria.

After more than 2000 years of history, today it awakens to an important rediscovery becoming a real bridge that connects and unites different cultures, traditions, environments and emotions passing between Italy, Austria and Germany. In the territory of Belluno, the Via first runs along the Feltrino area passing through Lamon - it is necessary to pass through the nearby and characteristic Roman Bridge - and then continues to Sovramonte. Here,

with a brief variation of the route towards Croce d'Aune, it is possible to stop in front of the Campagnolo monument, dedicated to the hardships of the climb that the cyclist Tullio Campagnolo endured during the Feltre stage of the "Giro d'Italia" in 1924, an experience that led him to invent the first gears for bicycles and with it writing a piece of two-wheeled history.

The Via continues downhill towards Pedavena up to Feltre; then it goes up towards Cesiomaggiore, to reach Busche where, crossing the Piave River, it continues in the Municipality of Borgo Valbelluna - with the medieval Castello di Zumelle - to reach the Praderadego pass that separates the province of Belluno from that of Treviso.

Each road is in fact dedicated to a great champion of cycling: getting lost in the midst of more or less hidden paths, on the slopes of the mountain, it is a pleasure to discover them all!

The history of the most important national cycling event has been written in the Belluno area: the ‘Giro d'Italia’.

For this reason, the name of a champion was given to every dolomite peak covered by the

centenary history of this appointment.

The Monte Grappa, as well as Cima Campo, Monte Avena, but also the Passo Croce d'Aune have therefore become a terrain of challenge and memory for the passionate cyclists who love the road route.

Discovering the treasures of water in nature

The Feltrino described according to a common denominator: water

A refreshing dip in the green Lago del Corlo in Arsiè, or a pleasant bike ride passing over the suspension bridge called “Ponte della Vittoria”, going up the Cismon stream to the fonzasina area. Or a change of perspective navigating the waters while exercising the legs with a pedal boat - or the arms by riding a canoe.

How many things can you do in a lake? For example, it can be the starting point for many mountain trails!

Going further in the discovery of the Val di Canzoi, with its characteristic Lago della Stua, there is a great opportunity for mountain lovers, “without too much effort”: an easy walk in the heart of the Dolomiti Bellunesi National Park which in a few hours gives a glimpse of marvelous waters, including the Anguane waterfall, whose name is linked to fairy-tale creatures: the “Anguane”, mysterious water nymphs of the Alpine mythological tradition.

Near the town of Orsera, reachable in a few minutes on foot thanks to the path accessible also to people with reduced mobility, there are the Laghetti di San Eustachio, a biotope consisting of several pools, located on the left bank of the Caorame stream. Another lake is found in the lands of the Fagiolo PGI, that of Senaiga, hence the name of the homonymous stream. The 62 m high dam is an important example of a double-arch dam designed by the engineer Carlo Semenza, who also designed the famous Vajont double arch dam. For a nearby walk in the woods, it is advisable to pay

a visit to the Salton waterfall.

For the tourist who travels through the Valbelluna, each stop in these areas is characterized by the presence of numerous waterways that over the centuries have strongly influenced the economic and social development of the area.

First and foremost is the river Piave, which stands out in comparison to its numerous affluents. This stream is also recognized as “Sacred to the Motherland” and overlooked by many architectonic features, from bridges to the most ancient structures, such as the Castelnuovo di Quero Vas. This particular building was bombed in 1917 during the Great War and then bought by the Somaschi preists who still manage it today as a House of Prayer and Religious Center.

From the acquisition of knowledge and awareness of a place where water is a key element, arises the work of enhancement of historical artifacts, an undergoing task in the last two decades. Among these is the Santa Libera mill in Salzan di Santa Giustina, a renovated heritage of rural civilization, which is now in perfect working order.

It is inserted in a crystalline path called Via dell' Acqua, which cuts through the Altanion to then wind through the countryside and flow into the woods, tracing paths and walkways along the Veses stream.

In a similar way, to celebrate the meeting places also in the smaller villages, in Alano di Piave there is a ring dedicated to water fountains that offers views of the countryside and the rural environment.

There are many ways to go solo or in company, but the climb up Monte Grappa is very inspiring, where you can enjoy the quiet of the white, seeing the valleys illuminated from above. For the true ski lovers in search of a family resort, welcoming and intimate, the right place for magnificent days on the snow away from the great masses of skiers, but at the same time with everything really close at hand, the inevitable destination is the ski area of Monte Avena, with over 20 km of ski slopes, ever-green forests and spaces for

freeride exploration as well as vast natural plains for walking with snowshoes and trails dedicated to cross-country skiing. This discipline is also available in the equipped area of the Prà del Moro di Feltre ring, with a view of the medieval Castello di Albino. Nearby, for those wishing to wear boots with blades, is a large covered ice skating rink offering a skate rental service and the possibility of courses for adults and children. With the arrival of Christmas, the Feltrino, a treasure trove of art, culture, history and traditions is enriched with living nativity scenes, Christmas markets, lights and Christmas gardens. FOLKLORE

Colors, customs and celebrations

PALIO OF FELTRE

Perhaps the most famous of all the folkloristic events of the Feltre area is the Palio, a celebration that evokes the donation of Feltre to Venice.

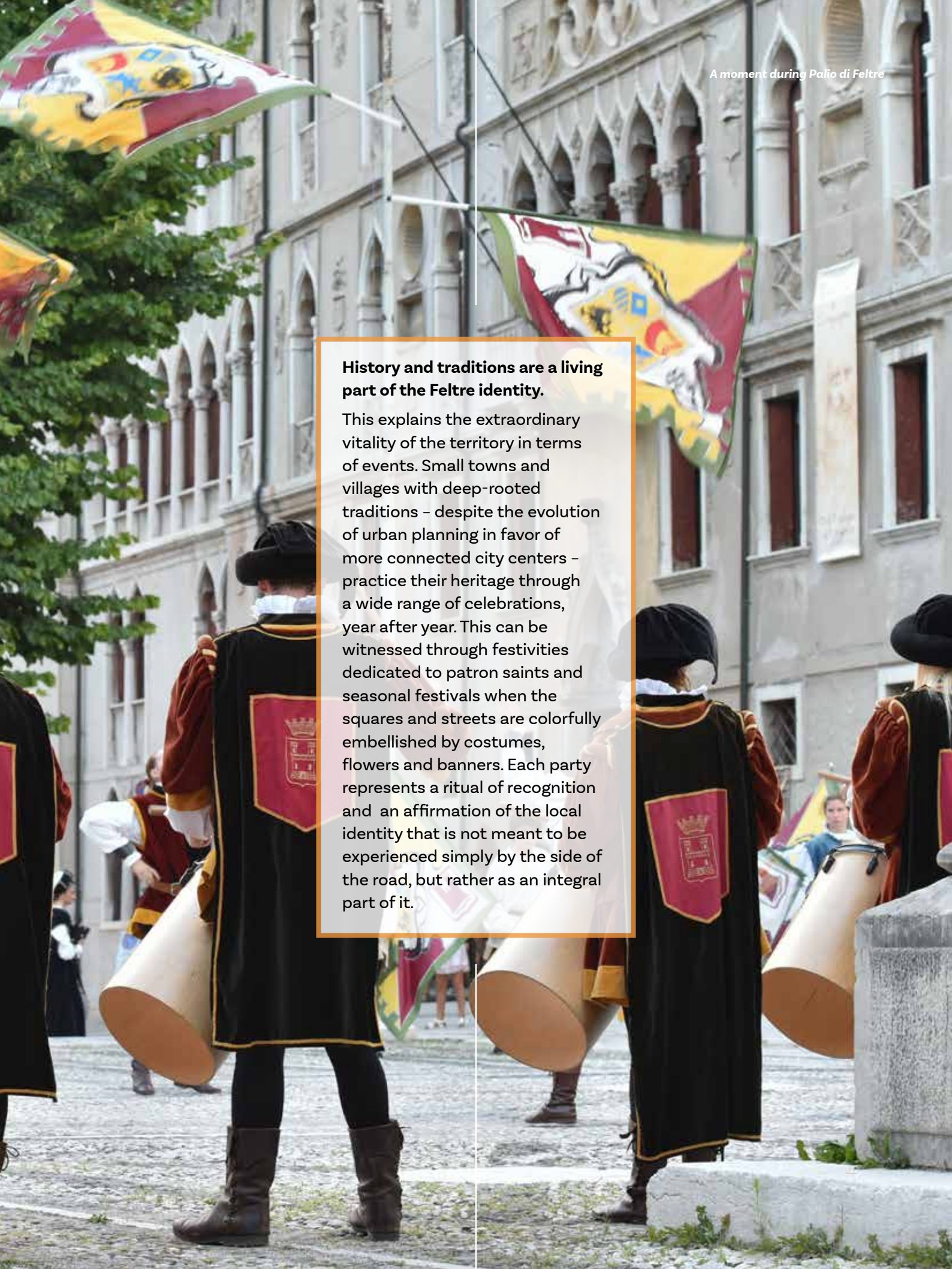
On this occasion, the village comes to life with costumed characters engaged in medieval activities, while the four city districts - Castello, Duomo, Port'Oria and Santo Stefano - compete for the conquest of the 15 ducati flag.

The event takes place every year in the summer and includes - in addition to the classic but always picturesque performances of flag-wavers and drummers and the dinner of the districts - in four exciting competitions: archery, relay race, tug of war and horse race. In the days of the Palio the atmosphere is very lively and in the streets you can breathe a cheerful but at the same time challenging air; numerous side events and activities to discover Feltre in a wonderful light!



History and traditions are a living part of the Feltre identity.

This explains the extraordinary vitality of the territory in terms of events. Small towns and villages with deep-rooted traditions – despite the evolution of urban planning in favor of more connected city centers – practice their heritage through a wide range of celebrations, year after year. This can be witnessed through festivities dedicated to patron saints and seasonal festivals when the squares and streets are colorfully embellished by costumes, flowers and banners. Each party represents a ritual of recognition and an affirmation of the local identity that is not meant to be experienced simply by the side of the road, but rather as an integral part of it.



HOSPITALITY IS INCLUSION: COME AND DISCOVER THE TRADITION WITH US!

Choosing the territory of the Prealpi Dolomites as a holiday destination can be an unrepeatable opportunity to visit an area where humans and nature have managed to combine beautifully what they do best. In fact “folklore”, in the Feltrino holiday area, means a deep love for one’s roots and the earth: here is a partnership between nature and man that throughout history has tried to blend best with the harsh surrounding environment.

Ancient customs are an integral part of everyday life. We are reminded of this by visiting the beautiful nineteenth-century country villa that belonged to the counts of Avogadro degli Azzoni, at the foot of the Belluno Dolomites National Park: the Museo Etnografico di Seravella (Ethnographic Museum of Seravella). This museum is not only an exhibition space where you can admire the peculiarities of the traditions of the Belluno land and its inhabitants, but also a place of study, cataloging and interpretation of popular culture from the second half of

the nineteenth century to the present day and is continuously being updated. Another place to find knowledge of the territory is represented by the Maddalozzo House Museum in Rocca di Arsiz. The Museum is set up in a typical rural house that has defended itself from the passage of time remaining almost unchanged for hundreds of years. It shows exactly how mountain people lived in the past by offering a glimpse into the intimate places where everyday life occurred: from the kitchen to the stable, from the barn to the bedroom.

During each festival that marks the changing seasons, the Feltre environment in its particular natural beauty, lights up at the spotlight: rites of passage, musical bands and group dances but also particular sights that become picturesque with the ever evolving colors that paint the scenery throughout the year.



The cold comes, the “Desmontegada” arrives

With the arrival of autumn and its splendid colors, many localities of Feltre recall their rural origins by celebrating the return of the animals from the high mountain pastures where they had spent the summer months. This colorful event that takes over the streets of the towns is not a simple parade of the herds that come down from the alpine pastures decorated – paradoxically – with flowers and bells that look very spring-like, but rather an actual thanksgiving ritual for an agricultural season that is almost over. Despite this tradition being centuries-old and the agricultural activities more and more diminished, in the last decades this type of parade has flourished also in the Feltrino where the “Gran Adunanza” of Pedavena is particularly appreciated, besides the Desmontegada that takes place between the territories of Alano di Piave and Quero Vas involving Malga Piz. In the same periods the custom also foresees the organization of various livestock fairs such as the “Mostra Mercato” of Santa Giustina, the “Fiera delle Anime” of Arsìe (which takes place since 1666 and represents one of the oldest events in the Feltre area) and the Autumn Fair with the feast of thanksgiving to Alano di Piave. The latter is an event centered on clothes used for work, or for the production of milk and wool but also and above all to make “becaria”, that is to procure butcher meat for the production of cured meats and sausages such as pastin and sopressa. As for sheep, they also have special parties, particularly the indigenous Razza Lamon sheep who have their own folk festival celebrated in the homonymous municipality.

Folk Groups and Town Bands

The music lights up the streets and the villages come alive with beautiful festivals not only to celebrate patron saints or seasonal food and wine, but also with festivals of a secular nature, not rarely accompanied by fairs, markets and rides. To further embellish this joyful frame we find the folk groups and the city bands, a great treasure of the smallest municipalities of Feltrino. The most consolidated in the territory are certainly the Cesiomaggiore folk group that brings the

traditions of dressing, dancing and playing as “na olta” (roughly meaning “back in the day”) to the present since 1971 and Lamon’s “Drio le Peche folk group” born in 2006. Three of the most well-known and numerous bands in the area are that of Arsìe, Feltre and Sette Ville. These three realities are always present in commemorative events, but also in the most festive celebrations in the area.

ARCHITECTURE

The architectures present in the Feltrino valley are truly varied and suggestive. They are witnesses and at the same time custodians of the territory: stones and leaves, wood and cement mixed with the knowledge and craftsmanship of the ancestors and much more.

Near the shores of Lake Corlo in the Arsiè locality where the Cismon torrent flows amongst rocky gorges into the vast plateau around Fonzaso, an excursion on foot or mountain bike will reveal the “barch”: rustic buildings formed by four poles at the corners and a tin roof used to collect hay. Looking upwards, one cannot but marvel at the hermitage of San Michele, a set of white buildings leaning against the mountain. In the first period after its construction, presumably by the Longobards, the main function of this building was that of an observatory for the defense of the territory. The Castle expanded beyond the current dimension but it is not only its size that has changed over time, also its functions. In fact, over the years the building also took on another purpose and became a permanent shelter for the “Fire Guardian”. Up until not long ago, the houses in the area were leaning against each other and built mostly of wood with a straw roof or wooden planks, presenting a continuous fire hazard. The task of the guardian was to sound the bell vigorous-

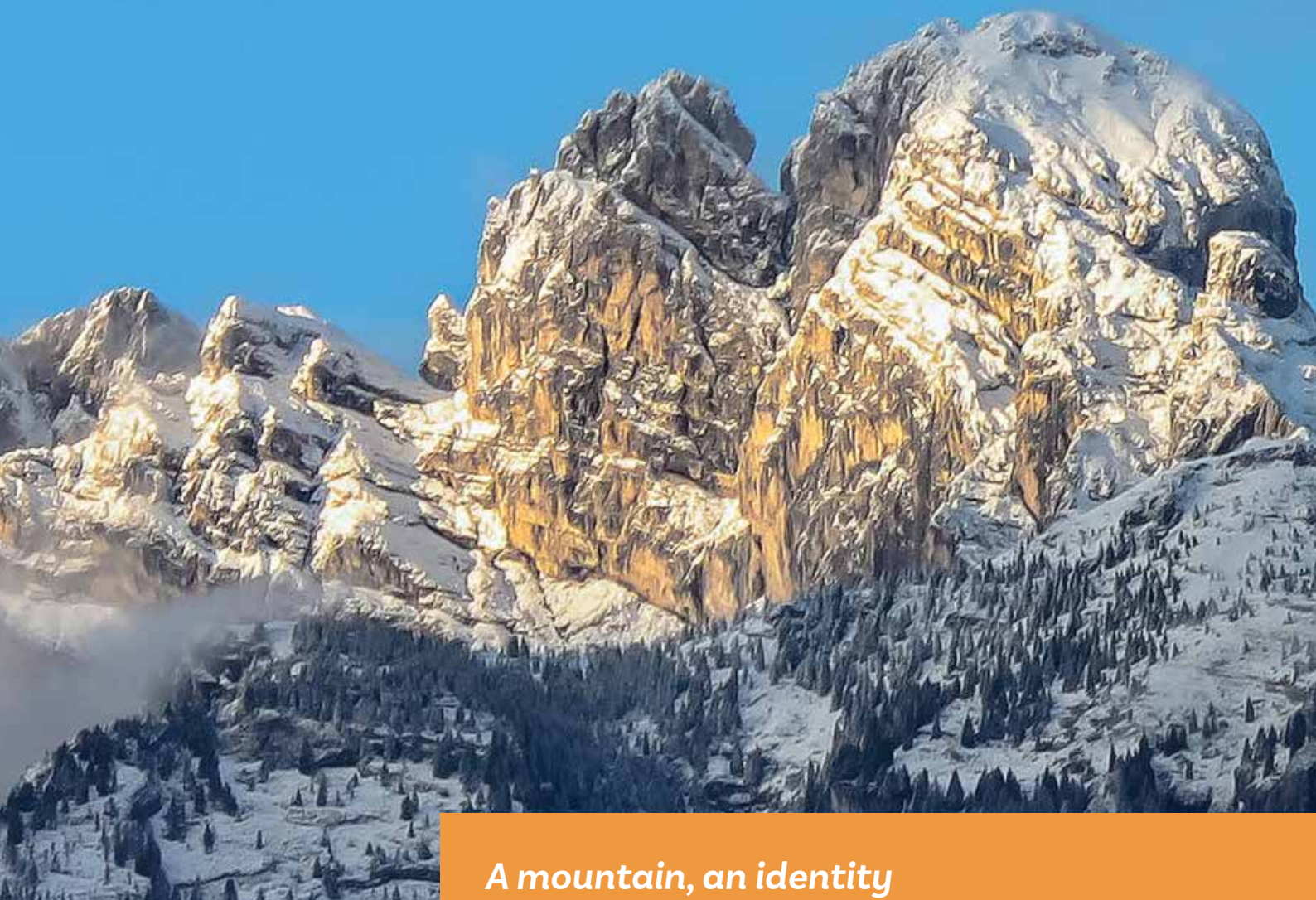


ly warning the whole town as soon as he saw a fire. In the Arsiè area, instead, the characteristic “solivi di Fastro”, or rural settlements, are a type of landscape architecture at the center of a territory once dedicated to the cultivation of vines, which illustrates the relationship between architecture and agricultural design. In Valle di Seren, in Valpore and its surroundings, another architecture of the territory characterizes the mountain environment: these are the “Fojaròì”, the mountain “casèra” with its distinctive roof consisting of branches of beech, tightly fixed together to form proper coverage. A square meter of this type of roof requires from 15 to 20 bundles tied to the poles of the structure weighing - depending on the size - about 120 quintals for each house or “casèra”. Moreover, given the durability of the branches - that must be collected in a special period of the year - the function of protection from water, wind and snow of this type of roof - called “foja” - is estimated around 80 years. Another traditional architectural technique is the “house

in steps” typical of the Sovramontine area. This architecture dating back to around 400 years ago is of Celtic origin and can be admired while walking among the green mountains.

From the rural to the homes of the nobility: white streets and majestic boulevards introduce the ancient mansions, where time often seems to have stopped and where love for the land is still evident in the culture of those who live there. Villa Tonello in Arten, Villa Fabris, Guarnieri and Villa De Mezzan in Feltre, Villa Pasole - Bertoni in Pedavena, Villa Norcen - Alvisi - Miari - Fulcis - Compostelle in Dussano di Santa Giustina, Villa Sandi in Paderno di San Gregorio nelle Alpi and then in the Cesiolino Villa Tauro called “delle Centenere”: these are just some of the names to look for in the trekking maps or in the bike routes that cross them and join them in a big road that cuts through the countryside, the scents, the sounds and the colors of nature that together represent the enchanting setting of the beautiful Venetian villas in the Belluno area.





A mountain, an identity

If Monte Avena is the most familiar mountain to people of Pedavena, - for those who live in Valle di Seren and in the area of Alano di Piave it is mount Grappa; for people in Feltre it is the Tomatico, for those in Sovramonte it is the Pavione and for sure the Pizzocco is the most recognizable peak for the people who live in the right-side bank of the Piave such as Cesiomaggiore, Santa Giustina and San Gregorio nelle Alpi. Monte Pizzocco offers a bird's-eye view which together with its modest technical difficulties, makes its summit an inevitable destination to visit specially at

dawn or dusk to enjoy an outlook into the horizon. On particularly clear days, from the summit that raises 2186 meters above sea level it is possible to see the Venetian lagoon. A fun fact: given its peculiar shape - on Cesio-Feltre side is wide and bulky with a tall and spikey rock formation called "Pizochet" (small Pizzocco) while on the side of Santa Giustina and San Gregorio is more slender and without protrusions - it means that as we move inland towards Feltre this great "stone" is recognized by the inhabitants of the different municipalities according to a different identity.

GIRO DELLA VALLATA FELTRINA - Cesiomaggiore. The symbolic race for future champions on two wheels. Organized by UC Foen.

SANVIDO CLASSIC - Cesiomaggiore. Cycling and historic competition dedicated to Sergio Sanvido in the most beautiful passages of the Feltrino territory.

GIRO DELLE MURA - Feltre. Over thirty years of international competition divided into 5 exciting categories: amateurs, firefighters, Municipal mile, Running seven laps, Giro delle Mura.

CAMPIONATO ITALIANO VELOCITÀ MONTAGNA (ITALIAN MOUNTAIN SPEED CHAMPIONSHIP) - Pedavena, Croce d'Aune. Uphill car race among the winding twists and turns of the road that leads to Monte Avena.

FIERA DI OGNISSANTI - Fonzaso. Market of goods, livestock and food stands.
